Town of Seabrook Island Proclamation 2017-03

Adopted: August 22, 2017

WHEREAS, The Seabrook Island Green Space Conservancy was first organized on January 5, 2000, to preserve the natural environment on Seabrook Island through the acquisition of land and land easements; and

WHEREAS, over the last seventeen (17) years since its inception, the Conservancy has acquired either by donation or purchase twenty-five parcels of property on Seabrook, each of the properties so acquired specifically chosen by the Conservancy because of its visual and environmental impact on our community; and

WHEREAS, each of the properties so acquired has been transferred by the Conservancy to the Seabrook Island Property Owners Association subject to a perpetual conservancy restriction; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday September 23, 2017, the Conservancy Board of Directors is providing Seabrook Island property owners and guests with an opportunity to visit each of the properties it has acquired to learn more about the Conservancy and its mission and to meet current and past Conservancy directors and donors.

NOW THEREFORE, in recognition of that event and in appreciation of the efforts and contributions of the Seabrook Island Green Space Conservancy to our community, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Seabrook Island hereby declare Saturday September 23, 2017, to be "Green Day" on Seabrook Island.
